Over the years, "God Rest Ye Merry, Gentlemen," with its simple, plaintive melody and joyous words, has become a holiday favorite the world over. Although this traditional English carol is often said to be in a minor key, it is actually in the Aeolian mode, (also known as "natural" minor), which is different from the more common harmonic form of minor in that the Aeolian mode's leading tone is a whole step from the tonic. The encouraging words of this carol are an inspiration to people everywhere:

God Rest Ye Merry, Gentlemen, Let nothing you dismay, Remember Christ our Saviour Was born on Christmas Day; To save us all from Satan's pow'r When we were gone astray O tidings of comfort and joy, comfort and joy; O tidings of comfort and joy.
