

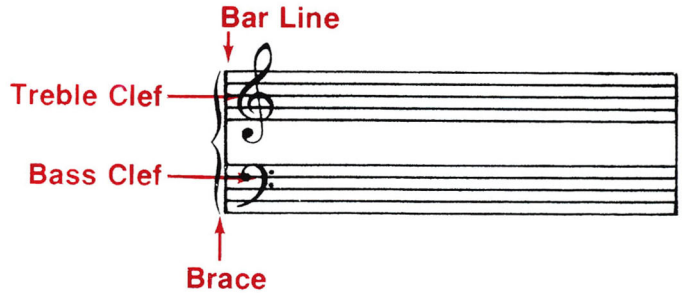

THE GRAND STAFF

Piano music is written on a GRAND STAFF which has two complete sets of lines and spaces. The upper part of the Grand Staff is called the Treble Staff. A Treble Clef or G clef  is used at the beginning of this staff. The lower part of the Grand Staff is called the Bass Staff. A Bass Clef or F Clef sign  is used at the beginning of this staff.









1. Draw some Treble Clef and Bass Clef signs on this Grand Staff.

The Grand Staff is formed by joining together the Treble and Bass Staves with a Brace and a Bar Line.

2. Make Grand Staves by adding clef signs, braces and bar lines.
