**Progressive Piano Repertoire, Volume Two** is a collection of early-intermediate level piano pieces from the 18th to the 21st centuries arranged in order of difficulty. It is appropriate for any age student and may be used independently, or as a supplement to any piano method. It is specifically designed to be studied after **Progressive Piano Repertoire (GP480)**. After completing Volume Two, students will be prepared for Level Four of Keith Snell's **Piano Repertoire** (Baroque & Classical, Romantic & 20th Century) or his **Essential Piano Repertoire** series.
