

About the Composition

The title refers to, most obviously, spaceflight. The movement is also inspired by the final words of the poem "Come to the Edge" by french poet Guillaume Apollinaire (1880–1918). The poem speaks of journeying past our old world to a new frontier. Finally, this movement is dedicated to Katherine Johnson (1918–2020), NASA hero and pioneer, who helped launch mankind into the heavens. Introduce the following new terms and concepts:

fp – forte-piano: attack the note strongly then suddenly play softly.

Marcato accent (A): a stronger attack than the common accent (>).

Rhythm: Triplet quarter notes.

Caesura (//): sometimes referred to as "railroad tracks," this indicates a silent pause during which measured time isn't counted.


