Jane Smisor Bastien has a special fondness for sonatinas and sonatas. In 1976 she initiated the Sonata Contest for the San Diego branch of the Music Teachers' Association of California and has been in charge of it ever since. Approximately 350 students representing 45 teachers participate in the event each year.
