FEATURES OF EXPLORATIONS IN MUSIC, Books 1-7

Students explore and discover new concepts.

Each concept is used in a variety of ways, always including opportunities for creativity.

Creative experimentation encourages students to compose.

Listening examples are interwoven throughout the book and presented on the cassette. They develop aural discrimination, score analysis, and interpretation.

Cassettes allow listening to be done outside of lesson time-at home or in theory classes.

Explore sections allow students to analyze the musical score with "eye and ear" and work creatively with musical ideas.

Explore Bonus sections offer the curious student a challenge, providing motivation to work beyond what is already presented.

Search for new ideas in this book and in the music they perform to discover specific information.




LISTEN
